Why was Jesus chosen by God to save the world?

Because He was the only one who could pay the price for our sin. Paul wrote, "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins" ([Ephesians 1:7](#)). His blood was the only substance that could redeem ("buy back").

A story (perhaps apocryphal) of Abraham Lincoln illustrates this point: One day Lincoln went down to the slave block and saw a girl being sold. He took money out of his pocket and bought her.

Then he said to her, "Young lady, you are free." She said, "Please, sir, what does that mean?" He said, "It means you are free." She asked, "Does that mean that I can say whatever I want to say?" He answered, "Yes. You can say whatever you want to say." She asked, "Does that mean I can be whatever I want to be?" He replied, "Yes, it means you can be whatever you want to be." She asked, "Does that mean I can go wherever I want to go?" He said, "Yes, you can go wherever you want to go." The girl thought, and as tears streamed down her face, said, "Then I will go with you." When sin put us on Satan's auction block, Jesus bought us back with His own blood. Paul wrote, "God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" ([Romans 5:8](#)). We will never understand that kind of love.

Walk through Jesus' biographies once again and see God's amazing grace as Jesus deals with people like us who are imperfect, flawed, and frail: Zacchaeus the tax collector ([Luke 19](#)).

The woman caught in adultery ([John 8](#)).

The Samaritan woman ([John 4](#)).

The thief crucified ([Luke 23](#)).

When we comprehend the riches of His grace, we, too, say, "Then I will go with you."


