Our worship service (10:00 to 11:30). includes communion service. The Collection Plate will not be passed. It is at the back on the projection table

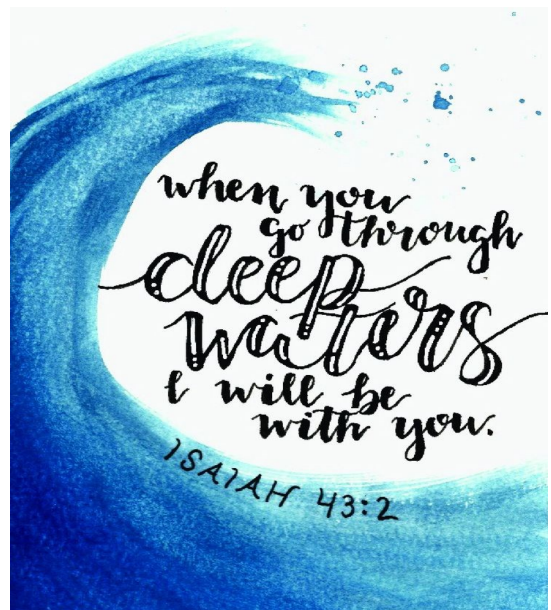

War for Your Heart

I read repeatedly of those in ancient times who had hard hearts – those who saw things like the ten plagues of Egypt and yet rejected the saving power of God. And make no mistake, not long after the bold display of Pharaoh's hard heart, we find the very people of God hardening their hearts. This is because a hard heart is what happens when a heart that loves sin encounters a powerful and gracious God. I see hard hearts everywhere – both in and out of the body of Christ. The author of Hebrews warns that we all need to watch out, lest our own hearts be hardened. But this begs the question – what should we be watching out for exactly? We need to look for the sin that is trying to win our hearts. And this is different for everyone. It could be pride, lust, covetousness, complacency, love of the world, no love for souls, ungraciousness, being divisive, being discouraging, being wasteful of your talents, not seeking to glorify God, and many, many others. There is a war for your heart. And if you don't fight for it, it will be hardened to the message of the cross. The love of Christ has no appeal to a heart that loves sin. (cf. Hebrews 3:7ff)
