Dane's brother, Brett, had heart surgery and is recovering- Is looking forward to gaining strength so he can return to the Prison Ministry with Dane

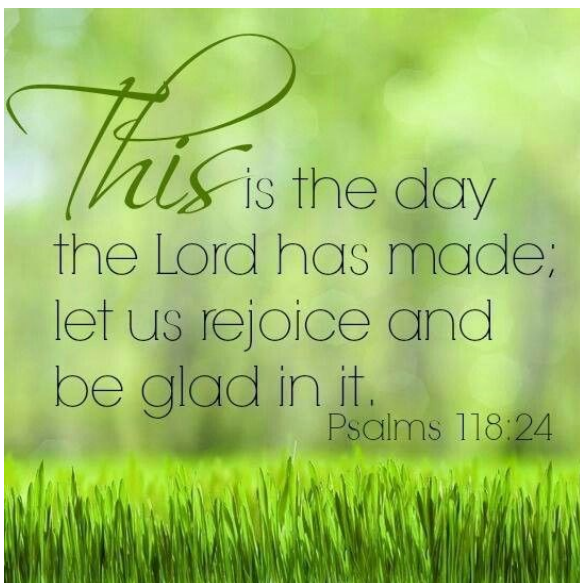
Kathy Henderson is still waiting for a surgery date continued to be thankful for the partial help she has received.
